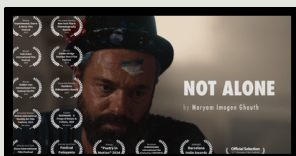
Literary Artist: Mallorca and Dubai

Maryam embarked on her journey into the arts in 2019. A year later, her poetry film series, *Journey of Becoming*, was chosen for screening at Dubai's art-house cinema, Akil, in celebration of female artists. Since then, she has directed twenty-five poetry films, many of which have been produced in both English and Arabic. In late 2023, she began submitting her works to international film festivals across Canada, USA, Europe, Australia, and South America, receiving several nominations and awards for her poetry films *Bubble Hat* and *Not Alone*. 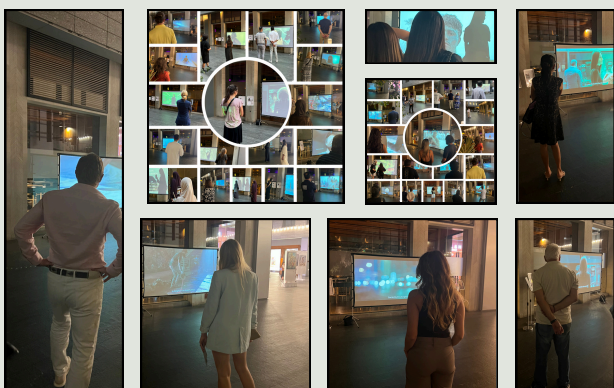


The Audio Form

Her poetry recordings have been featured as overlays in multi-award-winning short films, including *Under the Sun* by director Alla Dulh and *Just Once* by Zuhair Lokhandwala, the latter licensed for screening at the Art Museum of Nanjing University through 2025; as lyrics and spoken word for music producers and composers, such as Ricardo Haila and Arash Behzadi; and as guided meditations for wellness practitioners and projects, such as Ruqaya Ahmed and the biophilic design-centred development, Keturah Reserve. She is currently working on two novellas, a memoir, a book of poetry, and a collection of pensées.
